Why: Whether taking challenging AP courses or basic general education classes, many students need help in order achieve their full potential. No student wants to do poorly in school. For many, each day is a cycle of feeling lost in class followed by a steady stream of low grades. This instills a sense of hopelessness and apathy. For most of these students, reversing this cycle requires access to the same things we all need to learn effectively:

- Ample time in a place conducive to learning and the resources needed to complete assignments.
- Caring knowledgeable people to help prioritize assignments, to get students started and to help them when they are “stuck.”
- Accountability and recognition: for coming to school, for focusing in class, for meeting with teachers and tutors after school, for following through on work to complete at home.

Those of us who are fortunate enough to have had the help and resources we needed to be successful students can offer a helping hand to those who want and need our help to succeed in school.

You don't need to be a college graduate to help. Volunteer to help a student 1 on 1 with subjects you like. You don't have to remember everything you were ever taught in school. You might need to brush up on a topic or two to provide effective support, but we have the resources to help you do that quickly and easily.

If you don't want to tutor you can still help. We need volunteers to help schedule tutors and pair them with students in need.
